
The Alliance for Healthier Communities is the voice of a vibrant network of community-governed primary health care organizations.

We provide strong support to members who improve health and wellbeing in communities across Ontario.



What Does the Board Liaison Do?

Board liaisons have the responsibility to:

- Keep the Alliance board informed on issues most pressing for their organization and flag issues of common concern across membership;
- Learn about the provincial health system, issues and opportunities within the changing health system landscape, and share them with your Board.



Board Liaison Essentials

- Participate in the orientation webinar for new board liaisons
- Participate in two board liaison networking webinars: January, April
- Attend one face-to-face networking session and one virtual networking session:
 June, March
- Participate in one virtual Board Liaisons and Chairs meeting: October or November (November 1 this year)
- Participate in two health system changes webinars per year (open to all board members): November, May
- Review and share information from the Board to Board newsletter and other Alliance communiqués with your board
- Facilitate discussions with your board and collect feedback as required
- Keep the Alliance informed about any pressing issues your organization is facing










Self-Assessment Tool
